- 6. Students are required to have their own personal liability insurance which covers a minimum of \$1,000,000/\$3,000,000 aggregate. Student liability insurance can be purchased online through Healthcare Providers Service Organization at for approximately \$30 per year.
- 7. Students MUST demonstrate proof health insurance. This can be either through your parents/guardians or a student can purchase health insurance through Student Health Services.
