Information 1 Note to Table 1. (C) (15) (1) The following the typical fault clearing times of overcurrent protective devices:

(1) 0.5 cycle fault clearing time is typical for current limiting fuses when the fault current is within the current limiting range.

(2) 3.0 cycle fault clearing time is poical for insulated case circuit breakers with a short time fault clearing delay instantaneous range (i.e., "no intentional delay").

(4) 5.0 cycle fault clearing time is typical for low-yoltage power and insulated case circuit breakers with a short time fault clearing delay without instantaneous trip.
